Hydrostatic Lawn Tractors Recalled by Hydro-Gear Due to Crash Hazard

Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed. It is illegal to resell or attempt to resell a recalled consumer product.

Name of product: Lawn Tractors

Units: 100

Manufacturer: Hydro-Gear Limited Partnership, of Sullivan, Ill.

Hazard: A drive gear in the lawn tractor's hydrostatic transaxle can fail, posing a crash hazard to consumers.

Incidents/Injuries: None reported.

Description: This recall involves Troy-Bilt lawn tractors sold with Hydro-Gear model 618-04270B transaxle. Lawn tractors included in this recall have a date of manufacture (DOM) of January 2011. The DOM can be found on a label on the underside of the seat. Affected transaxles have serial numbers whose first four digits range between 0333 and 0348. Transaxle model and serial numbers are printed on a label on the transaxle.




Tractor Identification Photo and Sample DOM Label:
